## Registration step by step Year 2023/2024

Registration for courses in the winter semester 2023/2024 at the Faculty of Political Science and International Studies for Erasmus Students starts on **11th September** and ends on **22nd September**.

Students should register for courses according to their accepted learning agreements.

Registrations for classes take place at usosweb.uw.edu.pl.

Start with logging in. Click "log in" in the upper right corner.



You will next see the **login window.** Please, log in using credentials you receive from BWZ (International Relations Office) in a separate email.

In the **REGISTRATION CALENDAR** tab, after selecting the unit organizing the registration, the registration details will be displayed.

| Short<br>description:                            | The purpose of the course is to develop the student's knowledge concerning the Ukrainian contemporary domestic and foreign policy. In order to reach the stated purpose the emphasis is put on political and legal aspects of functioning main political institutions in Ukraine, analysis of modern political processes and domestic and international factors influencing the policy-making in modern Ukraine as well as processes inside civil society from the period of regaining the Ukrainian independence in 1991 till the outbreak of Russia's full-scale war against Ukraine. At the same time the course gives the students the opportunity to obtain the broader knowledge of particular type of concepts within political science as well as discuss the issues crucial for contemporary political systems and international relations. |  |  |  |  |

On the **Registration Calendar** page, we also have information about the term (time to the start of the registration round, and during the registration round, the time to its end).

By clicking the **Go to registration** link, we go to the registration window, where we can see all the registration-related items.

To register, next to the item in the **Actions** column, click the item icon.



Registration for the course will be impossible when the limit of places is exhausted. Information about the current filling level of all groups is shown in the bar in the Actions column.



Hovering the mouse over the bar displays information about the number of registered people and the limit of places.

Deregister is possible with the click on the icon

next to the wrongly selected item.

Clicking on the icon will take us to a page with detailed information about the number of registered people and the limit of places in each class group.
