For example: certificate (ITLZ, TOEFL, Cambridge, etc.) or confirmation from the University of Warsaw School of Foreign Languages. In exceptional circumstances: examination by a member of the Faculty.

Information regarding language proficiency should state at least B2 level or higher depending on the receiving institution's requirements.

In cases where the host university does not require a specific type of certificate, the student must submit a certificate at the B2 level or confirmation of passing the UW certification exam at the B2 level. In the case of English-speaking students - a certificate of study in English.

5. Statement from the Students Section of the Faculty (student office) containing:

- 1) Student's grade point average (BA students GPA from previous year, MA students GPA from BA diploma)
- 2) Confirmation of completion of previous study term
- 3) Confirmation of settled payments

STATEMENT REGARDING THE PROTECTION OF PERSONAL DATA

- 1. The administrator of personal data of candidates and qualified students is the University of Warsaw represented by the Rector, based at Krakowskie Przedmieście 26/28, 00-927 Warsaw, Poland. The administrator can be contacted by using one of the means provided on the website://www.uw.edu.pl/kontakt/.
- 2. The administrator has appointed a Data Protection Inspector (IOD), who can be reached at this email address: iod@adm.uw.edu.pl. The IOD can be contacted in all matters regarding the processing of data by the University of Warsaw and the use of data processing rights.
- 3. The personal data of candidates and qualified students will be processed for the purpose of participation in the Erasmus+ program.
- 4. Candidates' agreement constitutes the grounds for the processing of their data. Data of qualified students will be processed according to the agreement between the University of Warsaw and the Foundation for the Development of the Education System National Agency as well as Regulation (EU) No 1288/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 11 December 2013 establishing 'Erasmus+': the Union program for education, training, youth and sport and repealing Decisions No 1719/2006/EC, No 1720/2006/EC and No 1298/2008/EC Text with EEA relevance.
- 5. While the provision of candidates' personal data is voluntary, failure to provide them will exclude them from the qualification process. The provision of personal data of qualified students is obligatory and failure to provide them will exclude them from scholarship.
- 6. Access to personal data will be available to the Foundation for the Development of the Education System (Erasmus+ program operator in Poland) and the receiving institution where the student was qualified. Recipients of personal data may also include the entities authorized by law.
- 7. Personal data will be stored for the period of 5 years since the receipt of the document from the Foundation for the Development of the Education System announcing the closure of the project, at the latest until 31 December 2028.
- 8. Qualified persons have the right to access their personal data, correct them and limit their processing. Candidates have the right to withdraw their consent at any moment. Withdrawal ought to be communicated to address: swzmpb@uw.edu.pl
- 9. Candidates and qualified persons have the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection when they feel that data processing violates the provisions of Regulation No 1288/2013 (GDRF).
